

WFIA By-Laws Committee- Definition and Purpose

Definition

The By-Laws Committee of the Wrestling Fans International Association (WFIA) is a standing committee responsible for the oversight, development, interpretation, and maintenance of the Association's governing documents. The committee ensures that the WFIA By-Laws remain current, consistent, and aligned with the mission, values, and operational needs of the organization.

Purpose

The purpose of the By-Laws Committee is to safeguard the integrity and effectiveness of the WFIA's governance structure. The committee works to ensure transparency, fairness, accountability, and organizational stability by reviewing existing by-laws, proposing amendments when necessary, and providing guidance on governance-related matters.

Duties and Responsibilities

The By-Laws Committee shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

1. Review and Maintenance

- Conduct regular reviews of the WFIA By-Laws to ensure accuracy, clarity, and relevance.
- Recommend revisions, additions, or deletions to address organizational growth, legal considerations, or operational changes.

2. Amendments and Recommendations

- Draft proposed amendments to the By-Laws for consideration by the WFIA Executive Board and/or membership, as required.
- Provide written explanations and rationale for all proposed changes.

3. Interpretation and Guidance

- Offer official interpretations of the By-Laws when questions or disputes arise regarding governance, procedures, or authority.
- Serve as an advisory body to the Executive Board, committees, and officers on by-law-related matters.

4. Compliance and Consistency

- Ensure that WFIA policies, procedures, and actions are consistent with the adopted By-Laws.

- Identify and report potential conflicts between the By-Laws and other governing documents or organizational practices.

5. Documentation and Recordkeeping

- Maintain accurate and up-to-date records of all approved By-Laws and amendments.
- Ensure that current versions of the By-Laws are accessible to WFIA leadership and membership.

6. Governance Best Practices

- Monitor governance standards and best practices relevant to non-profit and membership-based organizations.
- Recommend improvements to strengthen the effectiveness and credibility of the WFIA's governance structure.

Authority

The By-Laws Committee operates under the authority of the WFIA Executive Board and shall not independently amend the By-Laws. All recommendations and proposed changes are subject to approval in accordance with the procedures outlined in the WFIA By-Laws.
